

Where is the truth knowledge?

Introduction

Through the history of the human kind, when this gets far from God, has searched questioning His existence, boasting in what humankind calls “human science” giving their thinking not a true science, based in their own philosophy, reaching the idea that our world was made by an accidental explosion, and the end of an evolution chain, coming from the monkey and some more theories like these, so that is something that has appeared to Paul in Athens.

Acts 17:22, 23²² So Paul stood in the midst of the ^[a]Areopagus and said, “Men of Athens, I observe that you are very religious in all respects. ²³For while I was passing through and examining the objects of your worship, I also found an altar with this inscription, ‘TO AN UNKNOWN GOD.’ Therefore what you worship in ignorance, this I proclaim to you.

Romans 1:19-22¹⁹ because that which is known about God is evident ^[a]within them; for God made it evident to them. ²⁰For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse. ²¹For even though they knew God, they did not ^[a]honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. ²²Professing to be wise, they became fools,

but even “science people” were and are able to see the truth.

What is that in us that makes us a rational and intelligent person able to solve any kind of struggles? Is it experience? Is it meditation? Is it philosophy? ... Or is it the preparation to get a job done?

Body

- I. Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom,
And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

What is it “the knowledge of the Holy One?”

- A. John 8:31-32³¹ So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, “If you continue in My word, *then* you are truly disciples of Mine; ³²and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.”

It means being free

- B. John 10:14 ¹⁰The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and ^[a]have *it* abundantly.

It is follow Him as our shepherd

C. John 13:34-35 ³⁴A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. ³⁵By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

1. Who is a disciple? The one that follows the teaching of his teacher
2. And it is love one another

II. Colossians 2:2-3 ²that their hearts may be encouraged, having been knit together in love, and *attaining* to all the wealth (As a result)

^[b]that comes from the full assurance of understanding, resulting in a true knowledge of God's mystery, that is, Christ Himself, ³in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. Have full assurance in the mystery of God "Christ himself"

A. Where He comes from?

John 8:18-19 ¹⁸I am He who testifies about Myself, and the Father who sent Me testifies about Me." ¹⁹So they were saying to Him, "Where is Your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither Me nor My Father; if you knew Me, you would know My Father also."

B. John 14:6-7 We know God through Christ

⁶Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

⁷If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; from now on you know Him, and have seen Him."

C. John 17:1-3 and 25-26 Jesus give Himself in sacrifice so we can know God

III. How can I get **truth** wisdom and understanding?

A. Asking! 1Kings 3:7-9 Salomon

Now, O LORD my God, You have made Your servant king in place of my father David, yet I am but a little child; I do not know how to go out or come in. ⁸Your servant is in the midst of Your people which You have chosen, a great people who are too many to be

numbered or counted. ⁹So give Your servant ^{an} understanding heart to judge Your people to discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this ^{great} people of Yours?"

B. Admiring His creation. Job 28:12-28

C. Experience. Job 12:12 ¹²"Wisdom is with aged men, *With* ^{long} life is understanding.

The experience makes wisdom through understanding

1. What is the difference between wisdom and understanding?

Answer: Wisdom is the practice of good and understanding the way to get wisdom

Invitation

Philippians 2 Therefore if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any ^{affection} and compassion, ²make my joy complete ^{by} being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose. ³Do nothing ^{from} ^{selfishness} or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; ⁴do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. ⁵Have this attitude ⁱⁿ yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be ^{grasped}, ⁷but ^{emptied} Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. ⁸Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death ^{on} a cross.

Colossians 2 ²that their hearts may be encouraged, having been knit together in love, and *attaining* to all the wealth ^{that} comes from the full assurance of understanding, *resulting* in a true knowledge of God's mystery, *that is*, Christ *Himself*, ³in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. ⁴I say this so that no one will delude you with persuasive argument...

...⁶Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so ^{walk} in Him, ⁷having been firmly rooted *and now* being built up in Him and established ⁱⁿ your faith, just as you were instructed, *and overflowing* with gratitude.
